There has been a significant change in the selection policies, with selection criteria now being much more heavily based on Objective scores rather than Subjective scores. This means athletes are aiming to hit scores based on their Difficulty and T.O.F scores only.

The first AWE Trampoline Senior National Squad Training Camp was held over the weekend of the 6th-8th March. The camp

was held at Eastlake's Trampoline Club, Newcastle, NSW.

The camp had four female and eight male athletes attend along with five coaches.

The camp focus was on planning and preparation for the build up to 2016 Olympics qualifications at the 2015 World Championships.

The athletes had the privilege of meeting Australia's only Gymnastics Olympic Medalist, Ji Wallace (who won Silver in the men's trampoline event at the Sydney 2000 Olympics), who gave a talk on his Olympic Journey and Trampoline career.

All athletes and coaches left the camp feeling motivated and positive going into our domestic season and national championships in May.

The next time the Squad will meet will be in Hobart, Tasmania in early July.
